## Early Childhood Program (Toddlers & Twos)

A secure, loving, caring environment helps children explore and grow in what is often their first experience away from home and helps each child learn new concepts and enjoy new experiences. While children this age are still mainly engaging in parallel play, they have the opportunities for cooperative play and socialization in group settings. Activities are appropriate to their rapidly developing physical, language and cognitive skills and include:

- ♥ Language development through books, songs, flannel boards and more
- ♥ Fine and gross motor activities
- ♥ Social-Emotional development through both adult and children interaction
- ♥ Creative expression through music, art, games and sensory experiences
- ♥ Dramatic, Outdoor and Indoor play
- ♥ Emphasis on self-help skills, such as hand washing, opening lunches and potty-training, depending on the stage each child is in.

## Preschool Program (Threes & Pre-K)

Preschoolers are aware of the world around them. They are capable of self-directed activities and also enjoy participating in group activities. Emphasis is on the development of the individual child as he/she operates in a group. Preschool classrooms are arranged into learning centers where children make choices and work together. The teacher acts as a facilitator encouraging child-centered activities that promote:

- ♥ Fine and gross motor skills
- ♥ Hands-on problem solving and exploration (science & math)
- ♥ Creative expression through art, music, and dramatic play
- ♥ Reading and story telling
- ♥ Increased participation in groups
- ♥ Self-help skills such as hand washing, opening lunches, bathroom skills and putting on and zipping coats.

Monthly tuition is calculated by totaling the number of days your child is scheduled to be at school, multiplying it by the daily rate and dividing by nine.

This results in nine equal payments (Aug/Sept - May). You pay the same amount each month regardless of the actual number of school days. The non-refundable enrollment fee is due at the time of enrollment along with the completed enrollment form and current immunization record. Tuition is due the first school day of each month. A \$25 late fee will be assessed on payments received after the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month. Missed days are not refundable.

### Withdrawals and Refunds

Withdrawal from the program requires a two-week notice. Tuition that has been paid beyond those two weeks will be refunded.
