Schedule

- Hours are after school-6:00 p.m.
- Three and five-day options

A Typical Day at New Haven

Schedule is subject to change.

Kindergarten—2nd Grade

- 3:00—4:00: Restroom Break,
Reading/Homework
Time, Snack
- 4:00—5:00: Playtime
- 5:00—6:00: All grades combine to
play together

3rd Grade—5th Grade

- 3:00—4:00: Playtime
- 4:00—5:00: Homework/Reading
Time, Snack
- 5:00—6:00: All grades combine to
play together

While Homework time is provided, it is self-directed and teachers do not assist children with their homework.

Playtime typically takes place on the playground; however, we also have access to the movie room and other rooms in the church in the event of inclement weather.

We follow Tulsa Public School closings for inclement weather.

Tuition

Enrollment fee

\$100/first child
\$75/additional children

Three days/week \$210/month

Monday-Friday \$285/month

Monthly tuition is calculated by totaling the number of days your child is scheduled to be at New Haven, multiplying that by the daily rate and dividing it by nine. You will pay nine equal payments (August/Sept-May).

The registration fee is non-refundable and is due at the time of enrollment along with the enrollment form and the child's updated immunization record.

Tuition is due the first school day of each month. A late charge of \$25.00 will be assessed on payments received after the 10th of the month. Missed days are not refundable.

Withdrawals and Refunds

Withdrawal during the school year requires a **two-week notice**. Tuition that has been paid beyond those two weeks will be refunded.



Transportation

We walk when weather permits. Please dress your children weather-appropriately.

We do not return to pick up children who participate in after school activities (Scouts, tutoring, etc.) Parents are responsible for arranging this transportation and for notifying New Haven of those arrangements.

Family Involvement

Families are always welcome at New Haven! We have a Family Resource Center full of helpful books and other information located in the hall, across from the office.

There is also a family bulletin board, in the gym, to help keep you informed about the program. Please take a few minutes each month to look at the bulletin board. There you will find the monthly calendar, other announcements, the dates of our monthly fire/tornado drills and more.

Our Parent's Association is very active and plays a very important role in our school. They plan several events throughout the year and encourage all parents to be involved.
